The Tour Actor/Directors will be contacting you the Tuesday before your residency begins to get additional information for the residency. They will discuss audition/rehearsal schedules and locations with you, along with housing arrangements. It will help tremendously if you have directions to all locations. They will also be setting up a contact meeting prior to auditions where they will need to see the audition/rehearsal locations.

Here is a **SAMPLE** rehearsal schedule (times are flexible to your needs):

- *The Tour Actors/Directors will provide the exact schedule at the audition.

Saturday's schedule will vary, but will usually consist of the Full Company arriving 1 hour prior to the first performance. Cast members called for both rehearsal sessions are asked to bring a sack lunch/dinner for the break.

Starting times are adaptable to fit your specific needs. Please remember that the time allotted for rehearsals is 4 ½ hours each day, so plan your starting time accordingly. Not all children will be called for every rehearsal.

Along with casting the children who will perform in the show, we will also be looking for older children to run the lights and sound and to be assistant directors.
